

Miss South St. Paul Candidate Information

Welcome to the 2010-11 Miss South St. Paul Candidate Program. The following information is not intended to be all encompassing, but will give you some of the information, which will be covered during the orientation session.

The Miss South St. Paul is **NOT** a beauty pageant. You will be judged on communication skills, personality, and public speaking ability. You will be observed by the Selection Panel at various functions and will have a personal interview with each of them.

As a candidate for Miss South St. Paul, you will be making public appearances from now until the coronation. You will have a banner with your sponsor's name on it and an identification button that you will wear at all candidate appearances.

During the appearances you will be identified as an Ambassador of Kaposia Days and of our city and we ask that you dress and act accordingly. This includes no gum chewing, no smoking, no consumption of alcoholic beverages, no foul languages, and no boisterous behavior. It is expected that you will be prompt, courteous, polite, and dress appropriately for each occasion.

Suggested dress for each appearance is listed on the Schedule of Activities. Please note that you will need a minimum of two evening gowns. The pageant gown is to be a floor length gown, with no midriff showing. Remember, when you are on stage, the audience can see your feet so please select appropriate shoes (no ballet shoes or flip-flops). Please refer to the Royalty Policies sheet.

When selecting your pageant gown, keep in mind that if you are selected as Miss South St. Paul or a South St. Paul Princess, you will begin making appearances in your own gown on Sunday at the Kaposia Days events.

Miss South St. Paul and her Princesses will wear formal gowns or professional business attire for appearances along with a crown and banner. Kaposia Days will provide the

banners, crowns, capes, and a clothing allowance for the official wardrobe as outlined.
